Lavender Sachets Tutorial

Little sachets to preserve the heavenly smell of lavender.

Material:

- Transparent white fabric: tulle, gauze, etc.
- · White sewing thread
- Color sewing thread to decorate the sachet, if you wish
- Lavender



Instructions:

- 1. Cut two 10.2 cm / 4" squares in your fabric. Place the squares back to back and keep into place with pins.
- 2. Sew all around with a straight stitch and a white thread, at a distance of 1.3 cm / 1/2" from the edges, leaving a 3.8 cm / 1 1/2" gap.
- 3. Insert lavender inside the sachet. Push the lavender to the side farthest from the gap and sew a straight line to close the gap.
- Sew over the straight stitch with a decorative stitch, using white or color thread. Push the lavender away from the stitching line to avoid stitching through the flowers.
