2. Measure 2,5 cm / 1" from the centre A (or more if necessary) and make a mark (C).

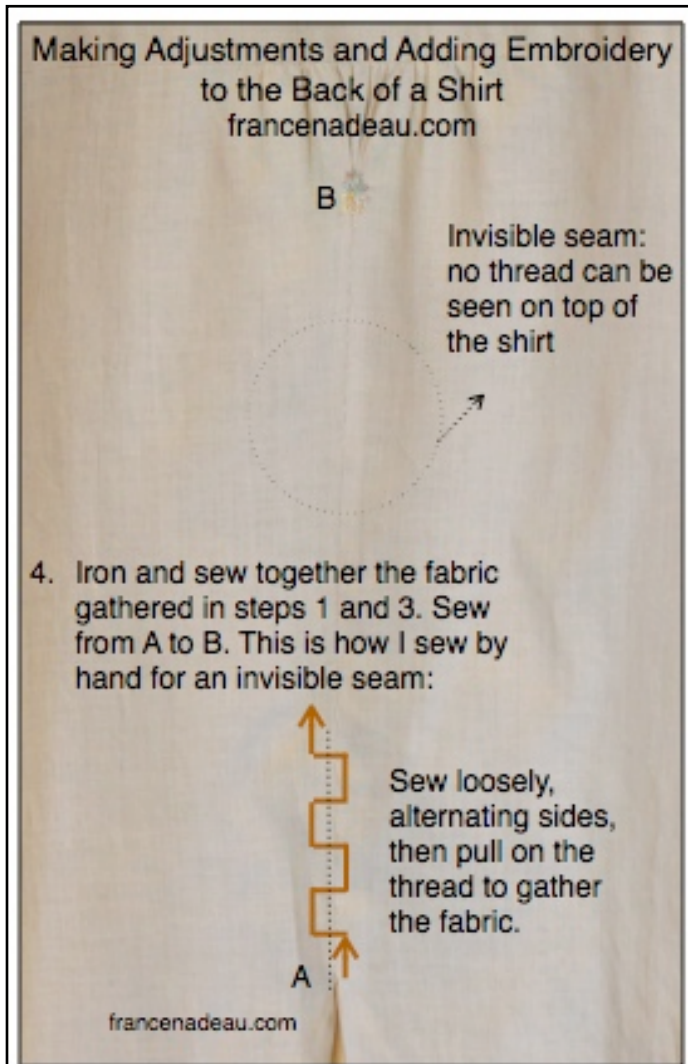
C A C

3. Gather the fabric from both C until they meet at A (folding the excess fabric neatly inside the pleat) and pin.

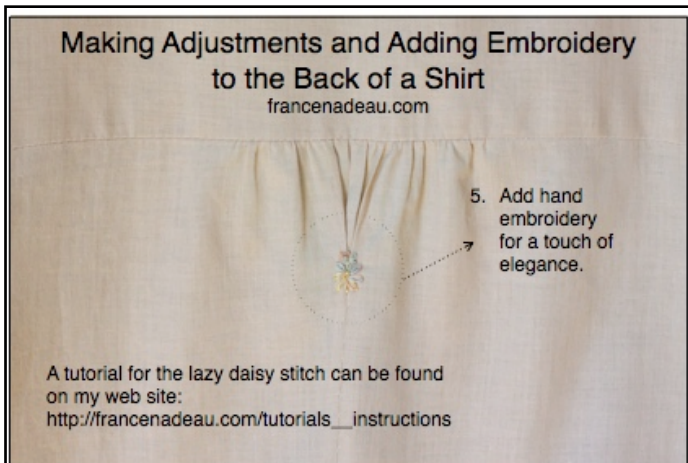
